

- **1.** Stay hydrated by drinking 6 to 8 glasses of water each day.
- 2. Avoid fluids that may irritate your bladder such as caffeine, fizzy drinks and alcohol.
- 3. Maintain a healthy diet with a fibre intake of 25-30g each day.
- 4. Do regular daily pelvic floor exercises to keep your pelvic floor muscles strong.

Male Specific Guards

Urinary incontinence pads with a contoured design to fit the male anatomy and sit securely inside the front of most firm fitting underwear. Bladder loss: light to moderate Capacity: 50ml - 575ml

Pull Up Pants

Adult protective underwear which fits close to the body and is less noticeable. This type of absorbent disposable product pulls up and down much like regular underwear. Also called adult pull-ups. Bladder loss: Moderate to Heavy Capacity: 600ml - 1500ml

Pad & Pants

Two-piece system is a highly absorbent pad with a waterproof backing which is secured close to the body using stretch pants. Bladder loss: Heavy to Severe Capacity: 1000ml - 3000ml

Incontinence penile clamps

Clamps placed around a penis to block the flow of urine and provide some control over when you choose to urinate. Exerts slight pressure on the top and the bottom of the penis and doesn't restrict blood circulation. To urinate, you release the clamp pressure around the penis allowing urine to flow into the toilet.

Condom drainage

An external urinary drainage system for men who are experiencing urinary incontinence. It is a 2-piece system that requires a condom catheter (sheath) and a drainage bag to collect and drain urine.



Condom Catheters

A latex or silicone sheath that is placed over the penis. The condom is attached to a tube. Urine drains through the tube and into a drainage bag. It drains urine without putting a catheter into the bladder through the penis. Sizes range between 18mm and 41mm. Contact us for a free measuring device.





A urinary drainage leg bag (also called a day bag) is attached to your leg. There are a range of drainage tap options to empty the drain bag with either T-Taps or Levers. Capacity: 350ml - 1000ml

Overnight Drainage Bags

Also called a night bag it can be added to a drainage system at night by connecting it to the day bag These bags can attach to the bed frame or mattress Capacity: 2000ml - 4000ml
